What is it?

Ocracoke Festival is a Folk Music & Storytelling Festival that fund-raises for the Ocracoke non-profit Ocracoke Alive. The weekend features performances, juried artisan booths, and LOTS of activities. Profits from the event support critical student and community arts and cultural programming on the island. It's a dern good time too!

When is it?

Ocracoke Festival runs June 2-4: Friday (2-10 PM), Sat (9 AM-10 PM), Sun (7:30 AM-4 PM)

Where is it?

On Ocracoke Island, at the Berkley Manor and adjacent properties, and other village locations.

How much does it cost?

There are a variety of ticket options (\$0-90) depending upon your budget. Tickets allow access to the three main stage areas. Prices range from All Weekend Passes (\$90), to single day passes (\$35-50), & evening passes (\$25). All students 0-17 years of age are free. Earlybird Tickets are available online til May 28. Adults can also earn free All Weekend Passes by volunteering 4 hours at the event. Volunteer spots are limited. Even if you are on a tight budget, there is an option.

What can I do for free?

If you don't have the time to volunteer in exchange for a free ticket, you can still . . .

- Visit the Artisan Village
- Catch Saturday Performances at the free OPS Museum Workshop Stage (9 AM-4 PM)
- See Saturday night performances around Ocracoke Village at the Ocracoke Coffee Company (6:30-8:30 PM), 1718 Brewery (7-9:30 PM), and Community Square docks (7:30-8:30 PM)
- Attend Sunday morning yoga (7:30 AM, Berkley Barn) & Sunday gospel sing (9:15-10:45 AM).
- Visit Ocracoke Village. It is also an awesome place to tour with shops, eateries, and lots to do. A free shuttle takes you throughout the village, or you can walk, bike or drive.

How do I get started?
